

World Earth Day 2026 Activities

Date: 22nd April, 2026

Theme: "Our Power, Our Planet"

A Hindi Message of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Himachal Pradesh was released in two newspapers through Department of Information and Public Relations GoHP on 22nd April 2026 and additionally, radio jingles were broadcast from 19 to 22 April 2026 on All India Radio, Radio Mirchi, Big FM, and Radio Dhamal. A brief report of field level activities are outlines below:

The Regional Laboratory, Sundernagar organized an awareness programme at Angels Public School, Purana Bazar. Scientific Officer Smt. Banita Thakur delivered a lecture on environmental protection, sustainability, and conservation of natural resources.

The Bilaspur office organized an awareness programme at Government Senior Secondary School (Girls). Around 150 students were sensitized on waste management, pollution, and environmental rules. Officials delivered informative

lectures on various environmental issues. A pledge ceremony was conducted to promote eco-friendly practices. The programme included interactive sessions to engage students.

The Rampur office celebrated Earth Day at Sunshine Public School with participation of around 350 students. The programme focused on environmental awareness and sustainable practices. Students shared ideas on pollution, climate change, and resource conservation.

The Chamba office organized an awareness programme at PM Shri Govt. Sr. Sec. School, Randoh. Around 250 students were educated on waste management and pollution issues.
