

Draft Standard Operating Procedure

Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change notified the Construction & Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016 on 29 March 2016. The rules are an initiative to effectively tackle the issues of pollution and waste management.

GoHP notified Himachal Pradesh State Policy and Strategy on Management of Construction and Demolition Waste vide notification no. UD-F (10)-2/2019 dated 20th July, 2019.

GoHP constituted Committee in all districts headed by District Magistrate for checking illegal dumping of debris and garbage for road construction activities throughout State including rivers vide notification no STE-E(3)-19/2019 dated 27th January, 2020.

A. Check List for registration under Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016

1. The operator of the facility shall apply in Form-I for authorisation from State Pollution Control Board, along-with copy of documents mentioned in the checklist, on OCMMS.
2. Site Clearance (from competent authority)
3. Layout map of the site
4. Land alienation order
5. Agreement between competent authority/ local authority and operating agency.
6. Plan for utilization of recycled product.
7. Expected amount of process rejects and plan for its disposal (e.g., sanitary landfill for solid waste).
8. Measures to be taken for prevention and control of environmental pollution.
9. Investment on project and expected returns.
10. Measures to be taken for safety of workers working in the processing or recycling plant.
11. Detailed Project report including following;-
 - Location of site approved and allotted by competent authority.
 - Average quantity and composition of C&D waste to be handled.
 - Details of C&D waste processing or recycling technology to be used.

- Quantity of C&D waste to be processed per day.
12. Preventive plan for accident during the collection, transportation and treatment including processing and recycling

B. Check List for renewal of registration under Solid Waste Management, Rules 2016

1. The operator of the facility shall make an application for the renewal of authorizations to the concerned Regional office of the State Pollution Control Board and the application shall be made in Form - I before sixty days of its expiry.
2. Copy of last authorization order issued by the State Board.
3. Compliance to the conditions stipulated in authorization issued by the State Board.
