

Draft Standard Operating Procedure

Solid Waste Management, Rules 2016

Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India vide notification on 8th April, 2016 has notified Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 in supersession of the MSW Rules, 2000 to focus on issues such as impact of solid waste on environment, best managerial practice and technology options for scientifically managing solid waste.

A. Check List for registration under Solid Waste Management, Rules 2016

1. The operator of the facility shall apply in Form-I for authorisation from State Pollution Control Board, along-with copy of documents mentioned in the checklist, on OCMMS.
2. Site Clearance (from local Authority)
3. Lay out map of the site.
4. Land alienation order.
5. Copy of Environmental Clearance & Consent for Establishment.
6. Agreement between municipal authority & operating agency.
7. Investment on project & expected returns.
8. Detailed project report for municipal Solid Waste Management.

B. Check List for renewal of registration under Solid Waste Management, Rules 2016

1. The concerned local body or operator of the facility or the agency authorised by local body shall make an application for the renewal of authorizations to the concerned Regional office of the State Pollution Control Board and the application shall be made in Form - I before sixty days of its expiry along with copy of documents mentioned in the checklist, on OCMMS.
2. Copy of last authorization order issued by the Board.
3. Compliance to the conditions stipulated in authorization order issued by the Board.
4. Agreement between municipal authority & operating agency.
5. Copy of Annual Report in Form-II as prescribed under Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
