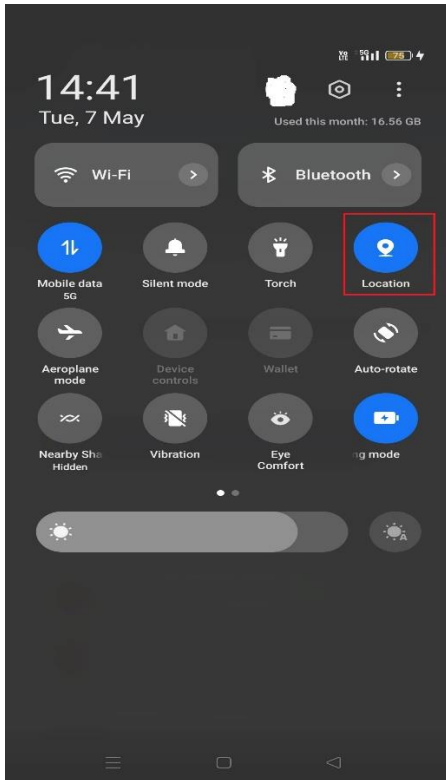
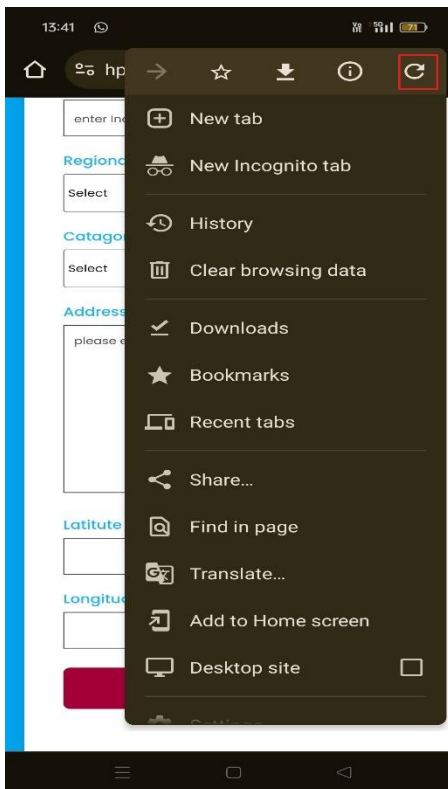


# How to enable GPS Location and Pop-Up

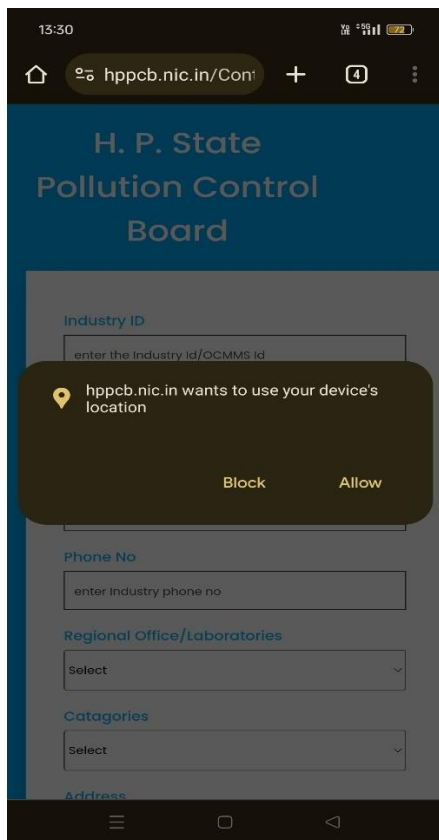
## Step1: Enable the GPS Location



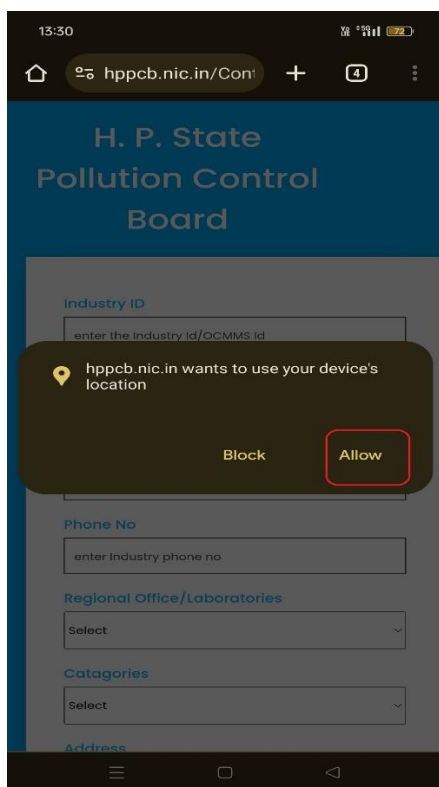
## Step2: Refresh/Reopen Contact Form



Step3: Pop Up is displayed for accessing the GPS Location




Step4: Allow the Pop-up GPS Location




Step5: after few second check **Latitude and longitude** are auto fielded

Step-7: if in case coordinates are not auto-filled, then Please Turn on the Pop Up in the chrome browser setting (top-right).

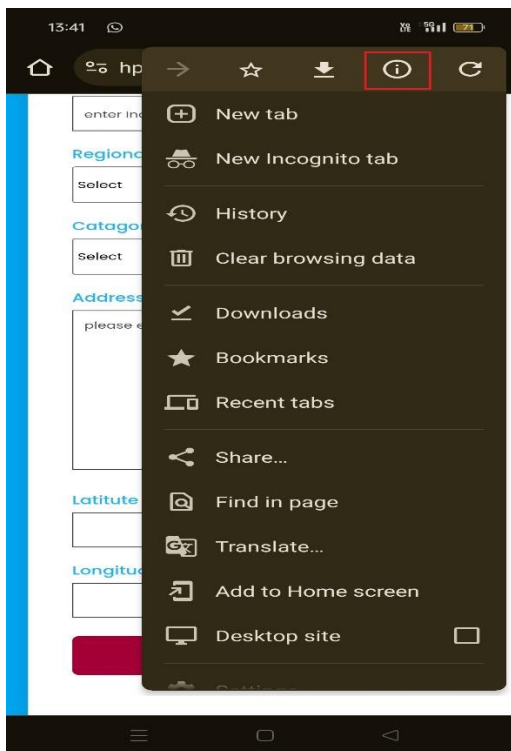

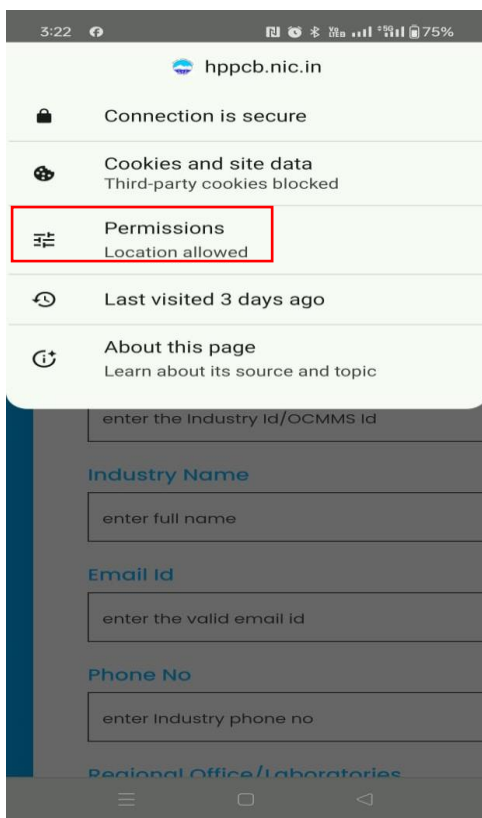
**Step-8: Turn on pop-ups:-**

2. Click on i icon in red rectangle (below)



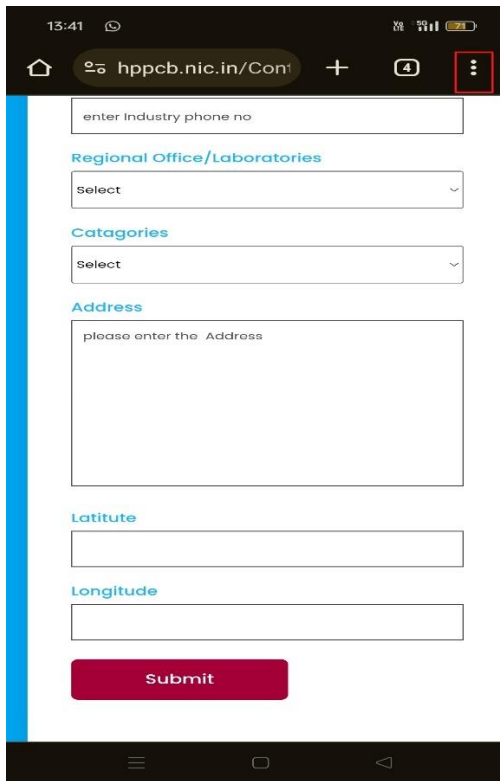
3. Allow permission



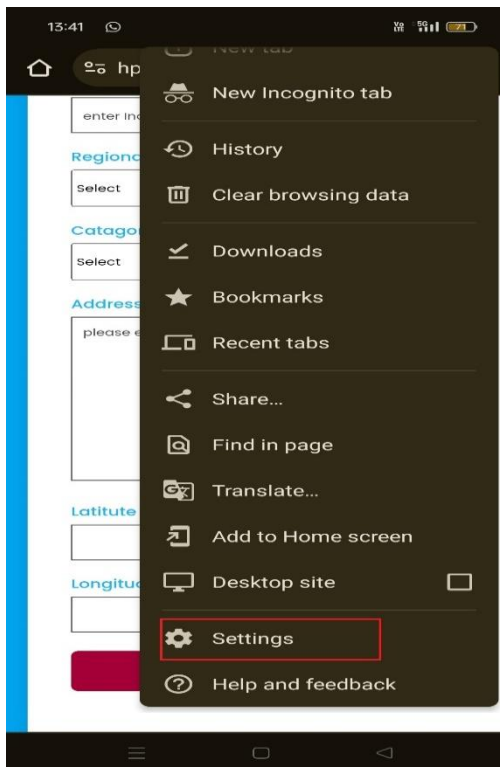
4. Refresh and reload form. It automatically fills latitude and longitude data.

## In Case If It Not Auto-Filled, Then Follow the Next Steps :-

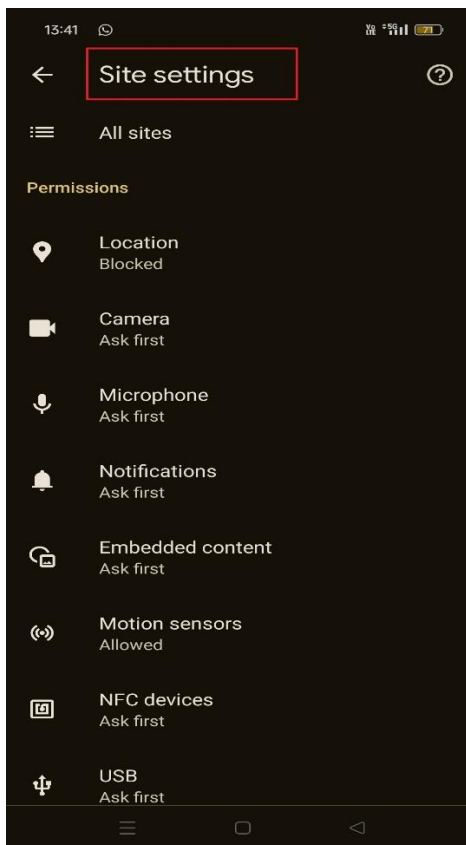
1. To the right of the address bar, tap More Settings.
2. If not Available then go to Chrome Setting option in the top-right displayed as three dots.



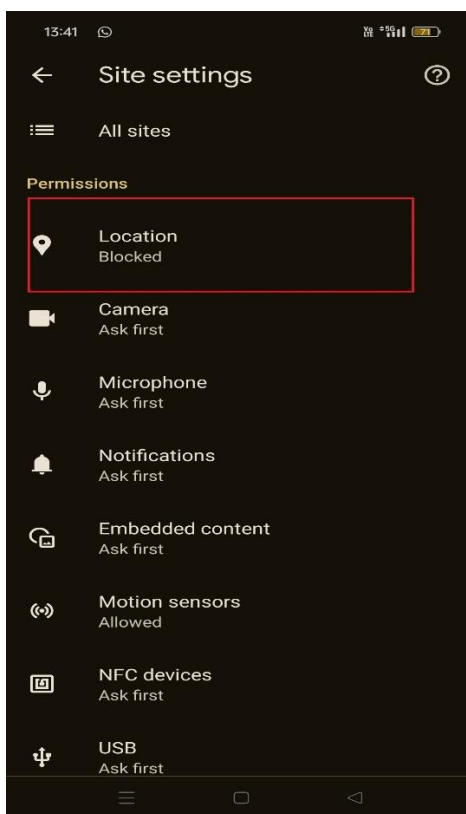
3. Click Setting



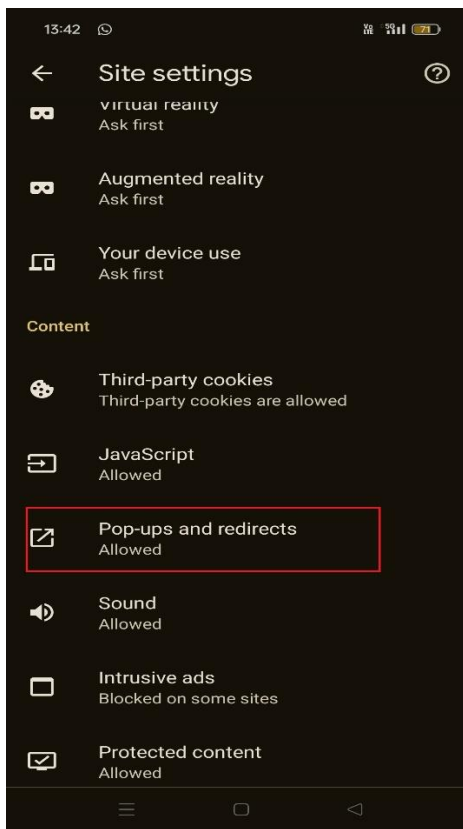
4. And scroll down and click on Site Setting



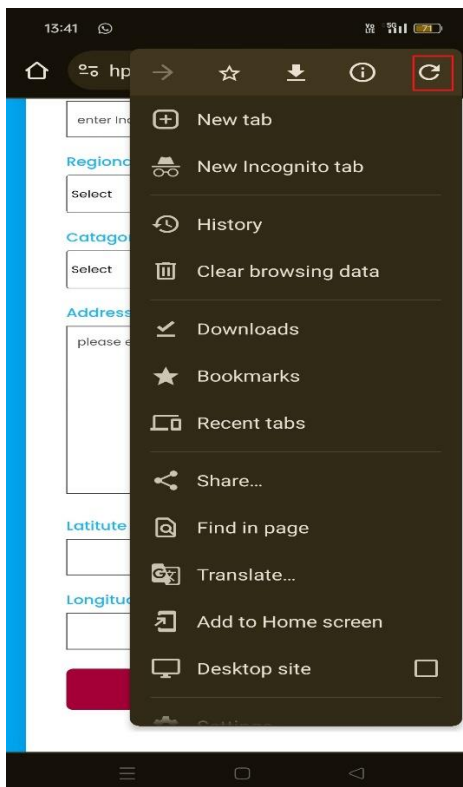
5. Allow/Turn on Location option



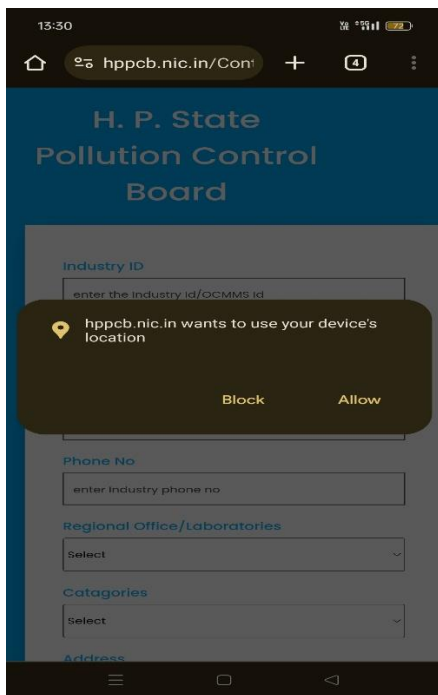
6. After that Allowed Pop-ups and redirects option
